
ACTIVITY ONE: BRAIN WARM-UP

SANITATION: conditions relating to public health, especially the provision of clean drinking water and adequate sewage disposal.¹

WATER SCARCITY: Scarcity in availability of water due to physical shortage, the failure of institutions to ensure a regular supply or lack of adequate infrastructure.²

2 out of 5 people worldwide do not have a handwashing facility with soap and water at home.³ **Colour** ²/₅ of the people:



1 out of 3 of all primary schools lack drinking water, sanitation and hygiene services, affecting the education of millions of schoolchildren.⁴ **Colour** 1/3 of **the schools:**



3 billion people live without basic hand washing facilities at home.⁵

What might be a consequence of not being able to wash your hands at home? 1 in 4 health-care facilities worldwide lack basic water services, affecting more than 2 billion people.⁶
