




## **BRAIN WARM-UP**

**REFUGEE:** a person who has been forced to leave their country in order to escape war, persecution, or natural disaster. <sup>1</sup>

**IMMIGRANT:** a person who chooses to migrate to another country, usually for permanent residence.<sup>2</sup>

More than half of children that have not enrolled in school live in sub-Saharan Africa.<sup>3</sup>
