<h2>BIODIVERSITY</h2>	<p>The variety of life in the world or in a particular habitat or ecosystem⁴</p>
<h2>AGRICULTURE</h2>	<p>The science or practice of farming, including cultivation of the soil for the growing of crops and the rearing of animals to provide food, wool, and other products⁵</p>
